BOYS

■ Junior forward Cameron Mattingly hit four three-pointers in the first half and finished with 18 points to lead **Woodford County** to a 62-59 home upset of No. 17 **Shelby County**.

■ Junior guard Chris Southall hit the deciding free throw to give **Marion County** a 68-67 home victory over **Campbellsville**. Junior forward D.J. Hall scored 28 points for Marion.

■ Sophomore guard Aaron Watts scored 27 points to lead **McCreary Central** to a 84-66 win over visiting **East Jessamine**. Darius Jackson led the Jaguars with 17 points.

■ **St. Henry** junior guard Joey Swikert scored 23 points and hit a free throw with 1 second left to give the host Crusaders a 73-72 upset victory over No. 21 **Boone County**.

■ No. 24 **Lincoln County** needed an extra period but put away visiting **Boyle County** with an 81-75 victory. Senior guard Ryan Young led the Patriots with 17 points. He scored 10 points in overtime.
