Xela drifted out a bit at the start bumping **Warn**, raced closest to the pace in the three path, moved in a bit before a half, challenged between rivals on the second turn, took over in midstretch then lasted late under pressure. **Cobrador** reserved along the inside, angled out three wide late on the second turn when advancing then rallied willingly late to be steadily getting to the winner. **Holiday Trip** forwardly placed along the inside, moved off the rail approaching the stretch but lacked a solid closing bid. **Anwaaal** unhurried while outrun, moved to contention along the inside on the second turn, lacked a clear path in upper stretch then had little left late when clear. **Safety Zone** bumped at the start, was unhurried for a half, raced three wide on the second turn and lodged a mild late bid. **Gasconade** rank at the start when in hand, stayed in hand for six furlongs and could not menace. **Angeloлие** drifted in at the start bumping **Anwaaal** at the start, raced within striking distance four wide, moved to challenge from that path on the second turn but tired once in the stretch. **Watchingirlsgoby** forwardly placed between rivals, gave way the final quarter. **Warn** bumped at the start, raced in the four path on the second turn and could not menace. **Cents of Humor** sprinted clear, set the early pace in the three path, moved in to save ground on the second turn, battled into the stretch and faded.

Paris Winds close up inside, moved off the rail on the backstretch, tracked the leader on the second turn, was blocked in upper stretch behind rivals, angled to the rail with a furlong to go and finished willingly to be upin time. **Quiet Jungle** never far back along the inside, angled out five wide when rallying late on the second turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but was outfinished. **Kiss With a Twist** outrun for a half, commenced her rally three wide on the second turn, angled out once in the stretch and finished willingly. **Italian Girl** within striking distance inside, waited once in the stretch, followed the winner into the final furlong but lacked a late bid. **Sousaphone** reserved three wide, made a good four side middle move, challenged once in the stretch but weakened. **Contentious** never far back three wide, made a run at the leader on the second turn, battled to inside the final furlong and weakened. **Aristo** close up off the inside, raced three wide into the stretch and tired. **Polo Lounge** unhurried for a half, saved ground on the second turn, worked her way out through midstretch but was no real threat. **Dowell House** set the pace near the rail, responded willingly when challenged on the second turn, held on well to midstretch and tired. **Im Classic Quality** within striking distance for six furlongs, came six wide into the stretch and tired. **Neon Lipstick** outrun early four wide, was no factor.
