Affiant, DET. TODD IDDINGS, a peace officer of LEXINGTON METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT, being first duly sworn, states he/she has, and there is reasonable and probable grounds to believe, and **Affiant** does believe, there is now on the premises known and numbered as:

PENDING

Affiant has been an officer in the aforementioned agency for a period of 9 years and 1 months. The information and observations contained herein were received and made in his/her capacity as an officer thereof. On SEPTEMBER 11, 2009, at approximately 6:35 a.m./ p.m., Affiant received information from/observed:

Lexington Metro officers were dispatched to 541 W. Short Street in reference to shots fired and a female screaming. Officers responded and discovered the body of Amanda C. Ross in the parking lot in front of her townhome near her vehicle suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to UK/er where she was declared dead. Witnesses state that around 6:30 am they heard the victim screaming "no" repeatedly in the parking lot in which her car was parked. No one was able to describe the suspect, but one witness stated that they saw a male running along the front of a row of townhomes leading from the victim's body to the gate facing Bruce Street. The victim had an active "no-contact" domestic violence order against her ex-boyfriend, Steve Nunn, a white, male with a dob of 11-4-52, with whom she lived for several months in 2008.

Acting on the information received, Affiant conducted the following independent investigation:

Lexington Metro police and other law enforcement agencies attempted to locate Nunn. Nunn was located at Cosby United Methodist Church in Hart County with self-inflicted wounds and was transported for medical treatment. Officers spoke with witnesses who indicated that Nunn ordered a grave headstone on 9-10-09, writing a death date of 9-11-09. Officers also spoke with witnesses who indicated that Nunn had indicated on 9-10-09 that his life wasn't worth living and that Ms. Ross had ruined his reputation. Officer recovered a file from Nunn's car (plate 156-CVR, which car was present at Church cemetery where Nunn was found) which contained photographs of Ms. Ross, correspondence to Ms. Ross, and other personal items. Officers also recovered a box from Johnny Hutchinson who stated that Nunn had given him a box of personal items for safekeeping. Officers interviewed Nunn's ex-wife who indicated he contacted her at approximately 11:30 pm last evening and told her where the key was to his residence and asked her to take care of his daughters.

Affiant has reasonable and probable cause to believe, and believes, grounds exist for issuance of a Search Warrant based on the aforementioned facts, information and circumstances and prays a Search Warrant be issued, that the property (or any part thereof) be seized and brought before any Court and/or retained subject to order of said Court.
