## Election Day Precinct Activities

### Initial Morning Tasks

- Arrive at polling place no later than 5:45 am
  - Do **NOT** wear any campaign shirts, buttons or stickers, etc
- Before any votes are cast, the election officers check each machine to verify the counters are set at zero, and to see whether the ballot labels are arranged as specified on the printed instruction cards. *Source: KRS 117.205*
- Attempt to determine that all voting machines are set to Zero
  - Ask kindly but do NOT argue if they don't allow us
    - Immediately call the election hotline to report these incidents
  - Verify make and model of voting machine (see individual County pages)
- Set up signs outside the precinct polling location, beyond 300 feet from the building entrance of the poll.

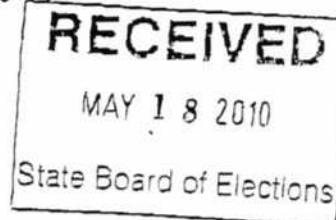
### Mid-Morning & Afternoon Tasks

- Perform Exit Polling from 8:00 am - 9:00 am
  - Do **NOT** wear any campaign shirts, buttons or stickers, etc
- Begin GOTV phone calls for your County
- Perform Exit Polling from 12:00pm - 1:00 pm
  - Do **NOT** wear any campaign shirts, buttons or stickers, etc
- Make remainder of GOTV calls
- If someone you are calling needs a ride to the polls, please try to accommodate them

### End of Day & Closing:

- Polls close at 6pm (all voters in line are allowed to vote)
- **At 5:45pm, present yourself to an Election Official and identify yourself as a representative of the Rand Paul campaign who will be witnessing the vote counting**
  - Do **NOT** wear any campaign shirts, buttons or stickers, etc
- Present the election official with your letter from the campaign
- Be familiar with the vote counting process outlined below, and monitor the process to ensure it goes exactly according to the process laid out in the law
- Verify the correct models of machines are being used
- **Immediately report an irregularities with the law to our election hotline**
